Tiger Cub Den Meeting #13

Elective 26: Phone Manners; Elective 27: Emergency!; Elective 15: Our Colorful World; Elective 12: A Friendly Greeting

Preparation and materials needed:

- Bring a U.S. flag.
- Bring several old telephones, crayons, and drawing paper or construction paper.

Gathering:

- Snack, collect den dues, record attendance.
- Have boys sign a note or card as a formal thank-you to the field trip site from the last meeting, if you had a host.

Opening ceremony:

- Conduct flag ceremony and Pledge of Allegiance.
- Distribute index cards printed with the Cub Scout Promise and Law of the Pack.
- Recite the Cub Scout Promise and Law of the Pack.
- Collect the index cards.

Advancement:

- Elective 26: With an old telephone, practice making phone calls and answering the phone.
- Elective 27: Talk about what to do if these things happen: The adult who is caring for you becomes ill. You are alone with someone who makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Electives 12 and 15: Using primary-color crayons and blending them to make orange, green, and purple, make two greeting cards for a hospital or long-term care facility. Ask the adult partners to help the boys deliver them.

Closing:

- Remind Tiger Cubs and adult partners that the next meeting is a Go See It.
- Hand out family information letter. (A sample family information letter can be found at www.scouting.org/CubScouts/Resources and on the CD in the Resources folder on the main menu.)

Next Up:

- For den meeting #14, make arrangements for a Go See It to visit a veterinarian.
- Submit a local tour permit application to your council service center two weeks before the trip. (The Local Tour Permit Application can be found at www.scouting.org/CubScouts/CubScoutingForms/forms and on the CD in the Resources folder on the main menu.)
